- 2. Grant Marshall spoke to the Board regarding the Levi Smucker Plan. The Board reviewed the comments from Light-Heigel and the Dauphin County Planning Commission. After review and discussion, Robert Stoner made a motion to waive the requirements for a preliminary plan and approve the final plan as presented and sign the plan with the required signature block. Second by Bob Coleman. All in favor, motion carried.
- **3.** The Board discussed the upcoming Spring Cleanup Event, which is scheduled for April 27, 2024, from 7 a.m. until 12 noon.

New Business:

1. Adam Steppy, with the Ned Smith Center, spoke to the Board regarding the Ned Smith 5k Run. Steppy said the event is scheduled for September 14, 2024, and that a portion of Water Company Road and Isle of Q Road would need to be closed from approximately 4:45 p.m. – 5:15 p.m. He said residents living in that area will
