STREETS

- I-1. Vacating a portion of Township Route 400 located North of U.S. Route 209, L.R. 199, in the Township of Upper Paxton, Dauphin County, Pennsylvania. (Ord. 10-12-1988, 10/12/1988, §1)
- I-2. Abandoning and vacating the road or right-of-way, being 33 feet wide and approximately 650 feet in length, extending from the northern right-of-way line of Senator Drive north to the southern right-of-way line of James Road. (Ord. 7-14-1999, 7/14/1999)
- I-3. Vacating a portion of public road or right-of-way located in the Township as depicted on a plan and profile of Tarry Hall Road, Drawing No. UP-607, dated March 14, 2006. (Ord. 9-13-06-B, 9/13/2006)
