Old Business:

- The Board reviewed the Analysis of the Possible Land Use Possibilities of Open Space/Conservation Design, for Upper Paxton Township, prepared by Tri – County Regional Planning Commission. - 5. The denial letter for a zoning permit, that was sent to Dan Schlegel, by Zoning Officer Marty Sowers, was reviewed. Luanna Zimmerman was told to contact Sowers and instruct him to schedule a meeting with Mr. Schlegel.
