Upper Paxton Township Board of Supervisors Regular Monthly Meeting October 8, 2019

Those in attendance: Ron Hepner and Robert Stoner; Supervisors, Luanna Zimmerman; Secretary/Treasurer, and Bob Coleman.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Hepner at 7:00 p.m. All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Public Comments: None

Approval of Minutes and Financial Report: Minutes of the September 10th monthly meeting were reviewed. Robert Stoner made a motion to approve the meeting minutes. Second by Ron Hepner. With all in favor, motion carried. Luanna Zimmerman presented the September financial report and a list of bills to be paid. Upon review of these documents, Ron Hepner made a motion to approve the financial documents. Second by Robert Stoner. All in favor, motion carried. Ron Hepner made a motion to pay the bills. Second by Robert Stoner. With all in favor, motion carried.

Old Business:

- 1. Ron Hepner stated that there is a CD maturing on 10-10-19 in the amount of \$150,000.00. Luanna Zimmerman provided the Board with interest rates from three financial institutions. Zimmerman stated that there were no special rates offered for a 6 month term rate. The current 6 month term rate is 0.35%. Robert Stoner made a motion to invest the full \$150,000.00 in a 12 month term CD, at the interest rate of 1.90%, with Mid Penn Bank, with the interest from the CD maturing on 10-10-19 to be placed into the General Fund Account. Second by Ron Hepner. All in favor, motion carried.
- 2. Supervisor Hepner informed the Board that the Kocher Hottenstein Glen Park tree planting has been postponed until sometime in the Spring of 2020 due to the preferred species of trees not being available.

New Business:

- 1. Robert Stoner made a motion to distribute Upper Paxton Township's allocation of \$18,255.15 in Foreign Fire Tax money to the Millersburg Fire Company (Relief Association). Second by Ron Hepner. With all in favor, motion carried.
- 2. Luanna Zimmerman provided the Board with a quote of \$4,000 \$5,400 from W.W. Pallet Company to have the debris at the Compost Lot, located on Isle of Q Road, ground up and hauled away. Ron Hepner made a motion to have W.W. Pallet Company do this work not to exceed \$5,400.00. Second by Robert Stoner. All in favor, motion carried.
- 3. The Board reviewed an invoice, in the amount of \$1,946.55, from L/B Water Service, Inc., for pipe that the Township roadcrew installed on Wagon Road. Robert Stoner made a motion to pay this out of the Liquid Fuels (State Funds) Account. Second by Ron Hepner. With all in favor, motion carried.

4. Ron Hepner made a motion to sell winter material (salt & anti-skid), at cost, to Millersburg Borough and Gratz Borough. Second by Robert Stoner. With all in favor, motion carried.

With no further business on the agenda, Ron Hepner moved to adjourn. Robert Stoner seconded the motion. All in favor, motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
