

**Upper Paxton Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
August 12, 2025**

Those in attendance: Robert Stoner, Bob Coleman, and Rich Wiest; Supervisors, Luanna Zimmerman; Secretary/Treasurer, Rodney Lebo, and Rhonda Lebo.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stoner at 7:00 p.m. All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Public Comments: None

Approval of Minutes and Financial Report: The minutes of the July 23, 2025, meeting were reviewed. Rich Wiest made a motion to approve the meeting minutes. Second by Bob Coleman. With all in favor, motion carried. Luanna Zimmerman presented a list of bills to be paid and the July financial documents. After review, Bob Coleman made a motion to approve the bills and the financial documents. Second by Rich Wiest. With all in favor, motion carried.

Old Business:

1. Rich Wiest said the paving project and the seal coating project on various township roads have recently been completed. Wiest said the projects both exceeded the contracted amount due to more material being needed than was estimated. Wiest said that he and Luanna Zimmerman met with PennDOT District 8 Representative Rick Levan and made him aware of this. Levan advised that a change order was not necessary due to the overage of both projects being under 30%. Possible road projects for 2026 were discussed and tabled for a later date.
2. The Board reviewed and discussed the agenda for the Tanner's Run meeting scheduled for 8-19-2025 at 9:00 a.m.

New Business:

1. Chairman Stoner made a motion to be a co-applicant with the Millersburg Senior Center for their Dauphin County Gaming Grant Application for the 2025-2026 grant cycle. The grant request is for \$20,000 to restore the bathrooms at the center. Second by Bob Coleman. All in favor, motion carried.
2. Bob Coleman made a motion to reinvest the CD maturing on 8/22/25, in the amount of \$204,509.63 plus the interest, with Mid Penn Bank for 6 months at the interest rate of 4.05%. Second by Rich Wiest. With all in favor, motion carried.
3. Supervisor Coleman made a motion to have the garage doors at the township garage building serviced. Coleman recommended that this is something that should be on a yearly schedule. Second by Rich Wiest. All in favor, motion carried.
4. Supervisor Wiest said he would like to get quotes to add a bay to the township garage building. He said this is something he would like to apply for Dauphin County Gaming Grant funding for the 2026-2027 grant cycle.

Public Comments: Rodney Lebo discussed the COG EMS study with the Board.

With no further business on the agenda Bob Coleman made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:41 p.m. Second by Rich Wiest. With all in favor, motion carried.
