

**Upper Paxton Township Board of Supervisors
Regular Monthly Meeting
June 9, 2026**

Those in attendance: Robert Stoner, Bob Coleman, and Rich Wiest; Supervisors, Pete Howland; Solicitor, Luanna Zimmerman; Secretary/Treasurer, Joe Underkoffler, Alex Martin, Jonathan Martin, Audrey Schulkins, Jack Ney, Larry Bates, and Crystal Leech.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Stoner at 7:00 p.m. All present recited the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Public Comments: Crystal Leech and Larry Bates spoke with the Board regarding 4 wheelers riding on property owned by Bates. They asked if they were allowed to construct a gate to prevent 4 wheelers from riding on their property. Bob Coleman advised them to contact the Millersburg Area Authority as they need access to this area. Coleman said they would need to have an agreement with the authority but as far as the township is concerned, they may construct a gate on private property. They also questioned the stormwater runoff in the area. The Board informed them that the township engineer is working to address this issue as it is believed to be the bottom portion of Tanner's Run.

Approval of Minutes and Financial Report: The minutes from the meeting held on May 27, 2026, were reviewed. Bob Coleman made a motion to approve the meeting minutes. Second by Rich Wiest. With all in favor, motion carried. Luanna Zimmerman presented a list of bills to be paid and the May financial documents. After reviewing Rich Wiest made a motion to pay the bills and approve the financial documents. Second by Bob Coleman. With all in favor, motion carried.

Old Business:

1. The Board discussed the model ordinance regulating data centers, provided to them by Tanner Stroup, of Tri-County Regional Planning Commission, with Solicitor Howland. Possible districts where a data center might be allowed were discussed. Chairman Stoner asked Howland to work on this ordinance so it can be revisited at the 7-14-2026 meeting.
2. Chairman Stoner said that the Board is still researching a way to make the Landis Drive intersection safer. This was tabled and will be revisited at a future meeting.
3. Robert Stoner asked for public comments regarding Ordinance 6-9-2026, amending the Township Code of Ordinances regarding the Enforcement Officer. With no public comments, Robert Stoner made a motion to adopt and sign Ordinance 6-9-2026. Second by Rich Wiest. All in favor, motion carried. Luanna Zimmerman said this was advertised in the 5-21-2026 issue of the Citizen Standard.
4. Rich Wiest made a motion to add an item to the agenda, Specifically, a Resolution appointing and confirming the appointment of the Township Code Enforcement Officer. Second by Bob Coleman. With all in favor, motion carried. Chairman Stoner read a portion of the Resolution aloud. The Resolution appoints and confirms Light-Heigel and the specific employees they designate to be the Upper Paxton Township Code Enforcement Officer. Robert Stoner made a motion to approve and sign the Resolution. Second by Bob Coleman. All in favor, motion carried.

New Business: None

With no further business on the agenda Bob Coleman made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:18 p.m. Second by Rich Wiest. With all in favor, motion carried.
