

Upper Paxton Township Board of Supervisors

Special Meeting

July 28, 2026

6:30 p.m.

Those in attendance: Robert Stoner, Bob Coleman, Rich Wiest, Supervisors; Luanna Zimmerman, Secretary/Treasurer; and Joseph Underkoffler, appointed liaison to the Millersburg Ambulance Association & appointed Board Member to the proposed Northern Dauphin Emergency Services Authority.

At approximately 6:49 p.m., the Upper Paxton Township Board of Supervisors met during the advertised meeting for the hearing and joint meetings of the municipalities in Northern Dauphin County to discuss forming an Emergency Services Authority.

After review and discussion, Bob Coleman made a motion to adopt and sign Ordinance No. 7-28-2026. This Ordinance "Signifies the intention and desire of the Board of Supervisors of Upper Paxton Township to organize an Authority for the purpose of administering Emergency Medical Services on behalf of the Township under the Pennsylvania Municipality Authorities Act jointly with certain member municipalities of the Upper Dauphin Council of Governments." Second by Rich Wiest. With all in favor, motion carried. (It was noted that this Ordinance formerly repeals the action taken on 6-16-26.) Ordinance 7-28-26 also appoints Joe Underkoffler to the EMS Authority Board for a term of 5 years.

Chairman Stoner recessed the meeting at 6:51 p.m.

At 7:07 p.m. Chairman Stoner reconvened the meeting. Bob Coleman made a motion to repeal the Ordinance that was passed on 6-16-2026 and amend Ordinance 7-28-2026 to note that there are 7 municipalities listed but Reed Township & Halifax Borough are not joining the Authority as of this date. Second by Rich Wiest. All in favor, motion carried.

With no further business on the agenda, Bob Coleman made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 7:10 p.m. Second by Rich Wiest. With all in favor, motion carried.
